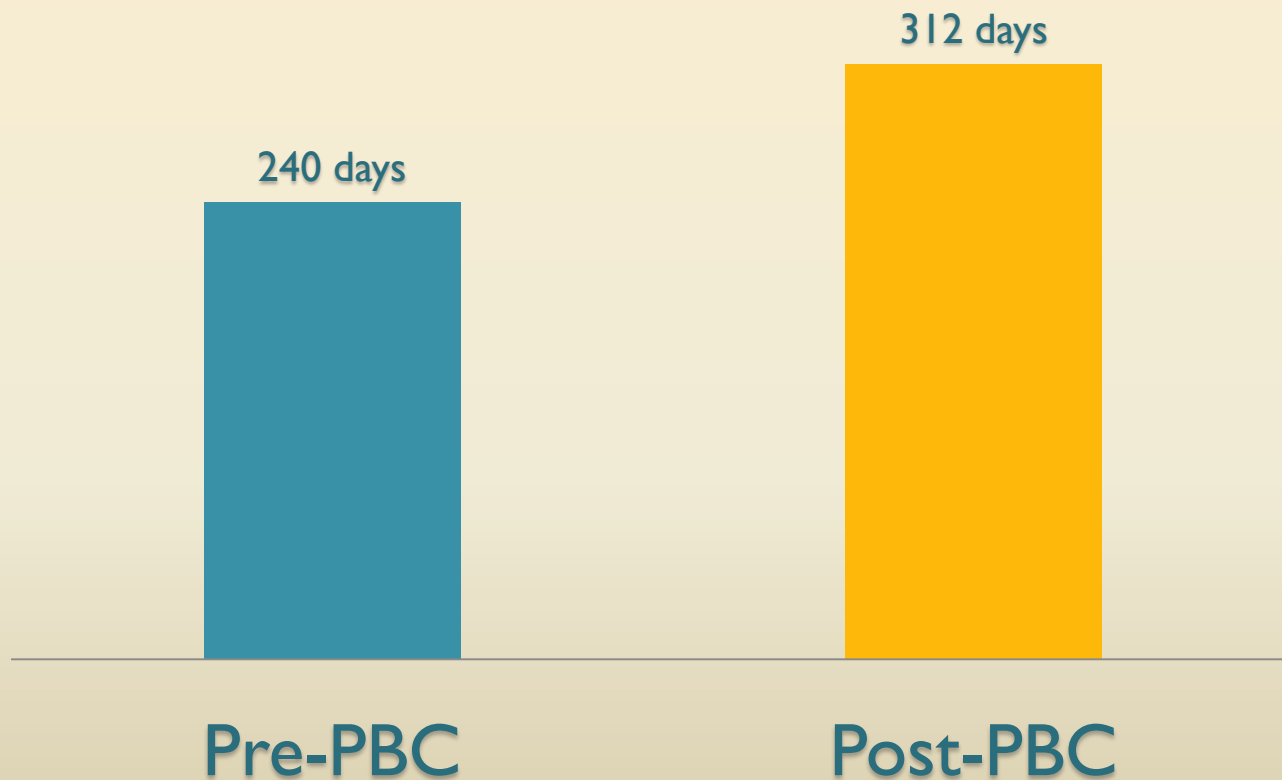

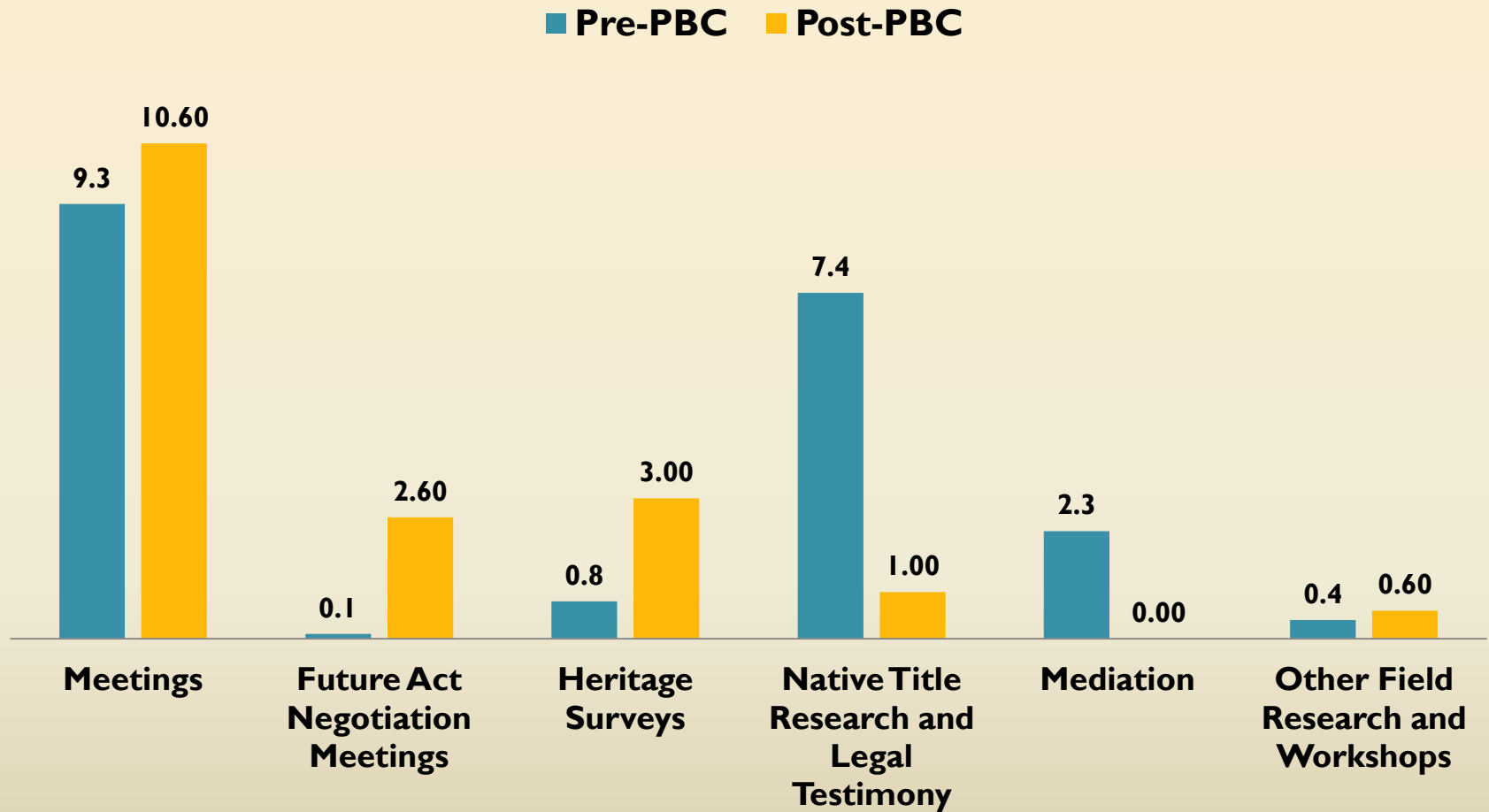




Average time the Nyangumarta group collectively spends on native title activities every year (person days)

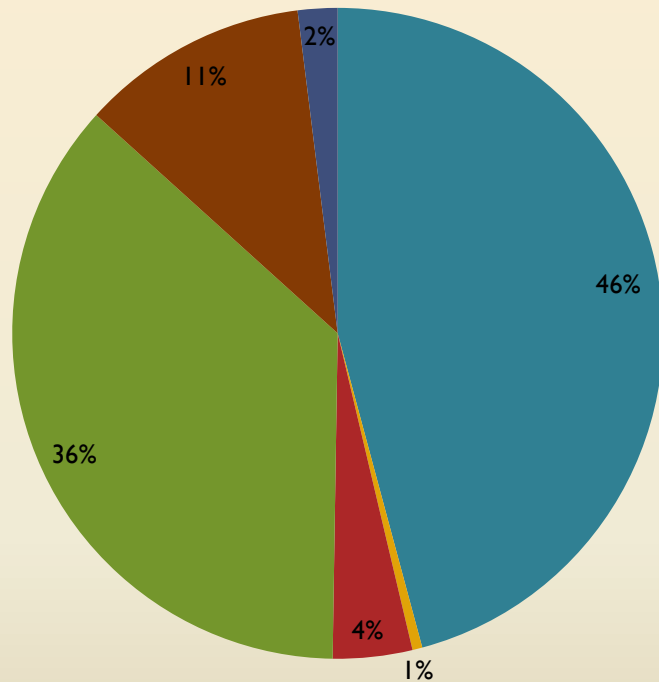


# Average number of events per year

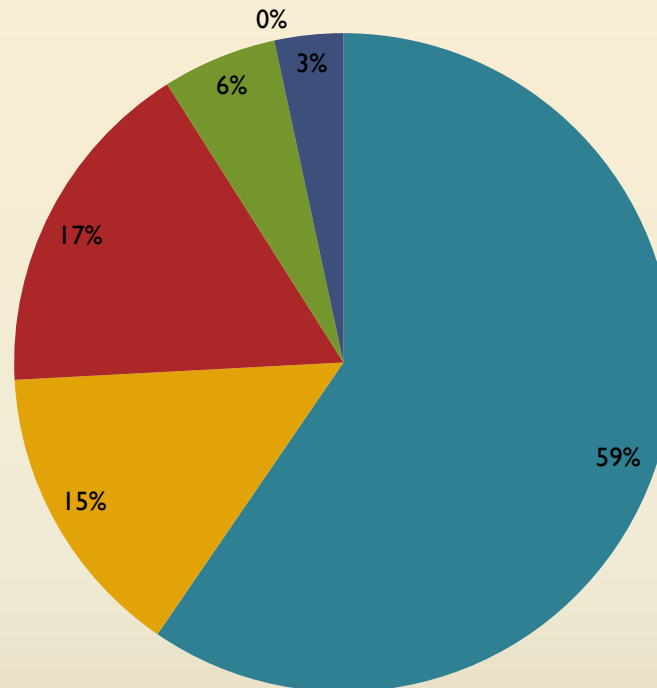

**Pre-PBC (1999 - 2009)**

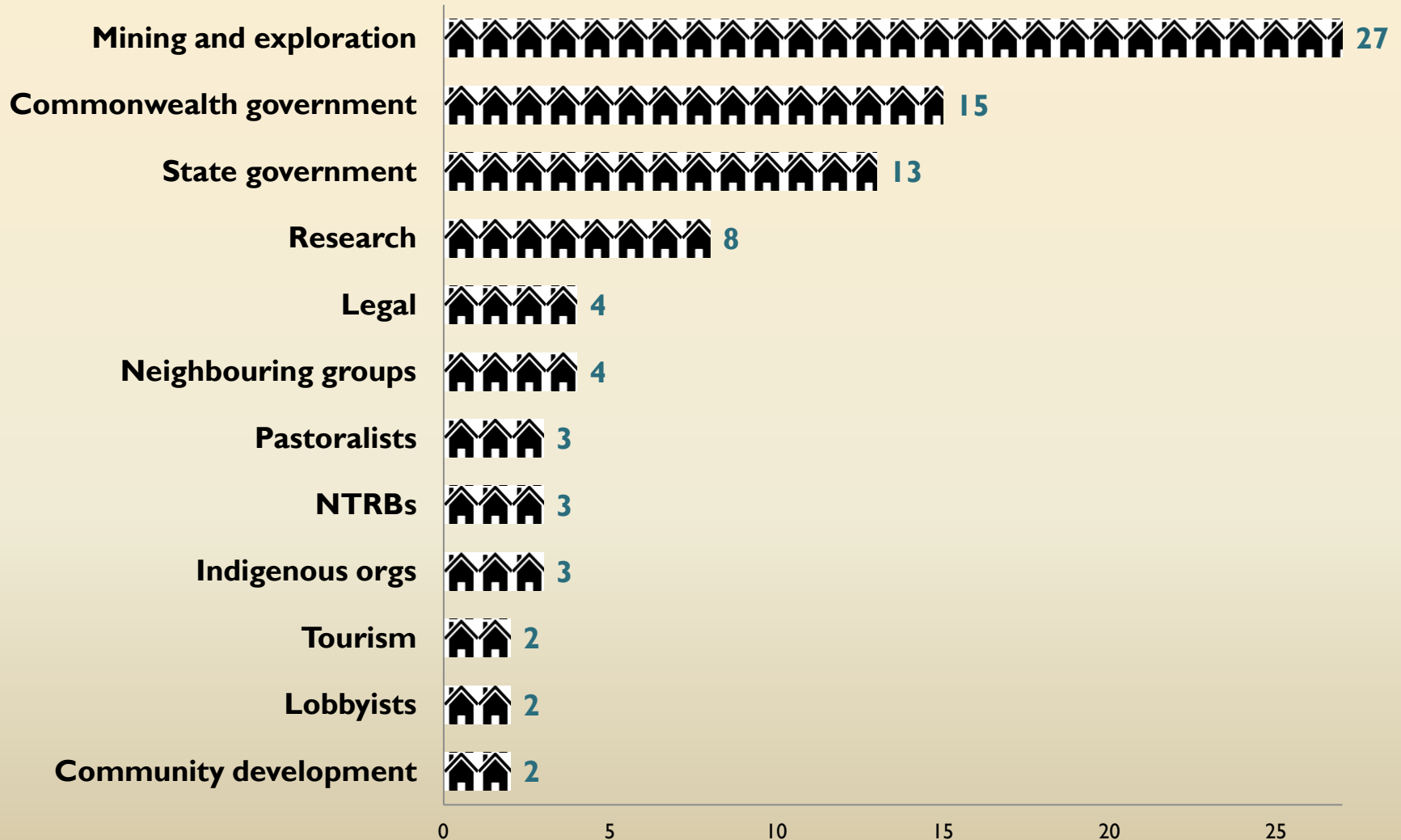


**Post-PBC (2009 - 2014)**

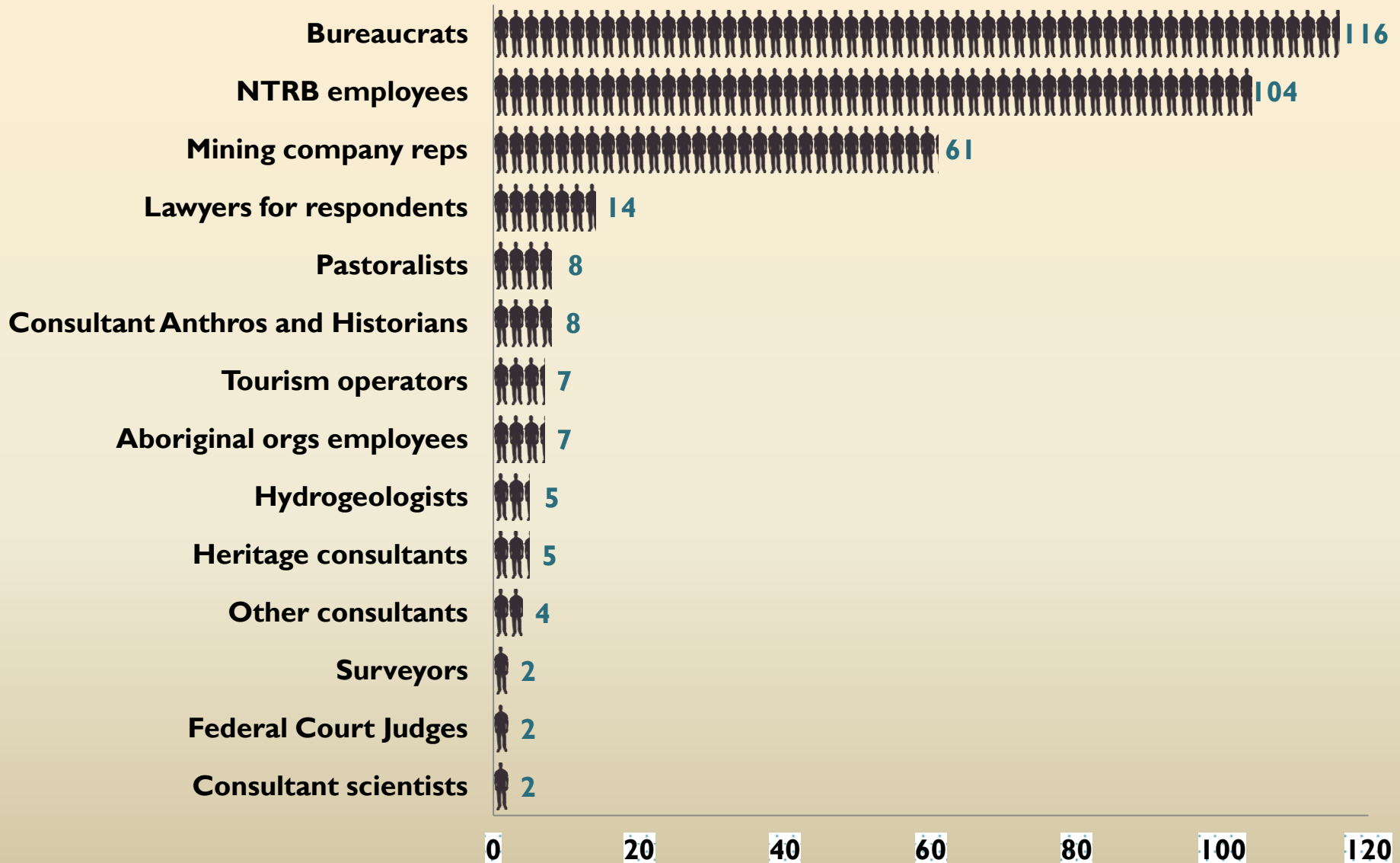

# Number of organisations involved in native title activities (1999-2014)




# Number of non-Nyangumarta people involved in Nyangumarta native title activities (1999 - 2014)
